Paisley Town Hall

TECHNICAL INFRASTRUCTURE & PRODUCTION TECHNOLOGY SUPPLY & INSTALLATION



Once a thriving hub of the town centre, by the mid-2000s, Paisley Town Hall became dilapidated and weighed down by an outdated technical infrastructure, which prevented it from hosting the community centric events Scottish town halls are well known for.

Northern Light, part of the Stage Electrics Group, worked with Renfrewshire Council and Morrison Construction, together with theatre consultants CharcoalBlue, to transform Paisley Town Hall into one of the finest entertainment venues in the West of Scotland. We specified, supplied, and installed production lighting, stage engineering and specialist technical infrastructure systems—improving the capabilities of the venue for years to come.


It was a great privilege to be invited to assist Renfrewshire Council with the redevelopment of Paisley Town Hall.




THE CHALLENGE

The brief was clear: 'Create a landmark entertainment venue in the West of Scotland, which preserves the beautiful architectural features but adds 21st century facilities, broadening the range of events capable of being hosted at Paisley Town Hall.'

The principal hurdle to overcome on a project like this, is installing a contemporary design within a grade two listed building. Strict regulations and boundaries must be observed, respecting parts of the building which need to remain untouched—with greater scrutiny from building inspectors than on many new builds.

Throughout the project there were various hurdles to overcome in the construction process which were out of our hands. We had to regularly adapt and show true agility to get this project finished on time.



THE SOLUTION

The first step of the project was for Northern Light's design engineers to further develop and complete the concept provided by CharcoalBlue. Before the work on site commenced, we supplied our client with a fully costed plan and schedule of work, which included over 140 CAD illustrations, covering every stage of the project.

Once the updated design was agreed, we set about installing the technical infrastructure, defined during the design process to satisfy the exact requirements of Paisley Town Hall. We supplied and installed over 36km of specialist AV cables, six AV equipment racks and 86 custom-made facility panels—the location of which was carefully considered to minimise additional cables when plugging up equipment.


Although the lighting systems in the refurbished Paisley Town Hall are all

LED, our client requested 140 through power/dimming circuits, powered by ETC Sensor dimmers, to accommodate touring productions with tungsten lighting fixtures.

Our team also integrated an ETC Paradigm lighting control system into the venue for house lights and work lights, making it easy for staff to control the venue lighting from a single touchscreen device.

We specified, supplied, and installed all production lighting, audio and video equipment for the main auditorium which, thanks to clever work by the architects, increased in capacity from 1000 in the original venue, to 1200 in the refurbished Paisley Town Hall.

An ETC Apex console controls the lighting rig, with fixtures from Chauvet, ETC, High End and Robert Juliat.





An Allen & Heath D-Live S5000 console is at the heart of the audio system, with an L'Acoustics A-Series production loudspeaker system. Radio microphones and assisted listening systems from Sennheiser complete the high-quality audio set-up. The projection installation uses Black Magic for control and distribution, powering Panasonic projectors mounted in the truss. All production cabling is from StageCable, a high-quality brand available exclusively through Stage Electrics and Northern Light.

Stage management desks ensure technical and acting talent alike is cued and communicated with effectively. The custom configured Stage Management Desk, designed and supplied by Stage Electrics during the project was equipped with show relay video displays, intercom, paging capabilities and cue lights enabling Stage Managers at Paisley Town Hall to benefit from up-to-date communication systems.




Our knowledge of working in historic buildings was key to guiding the Paisley Town Hall project through numerous hurdles and fluid timeframes.
